


## DIVINE & SPIRITUAL TOUR

(AAT-IND-008-D&P)

(5Days/ 4Nights)



**Spirituality in India:** In India, spiritualism is not an obsession of the human mind, rather it is a heritage as well as a continuous tradition.

Spiritualism is also defined as the science of soul or *adhyaatmavidya*, the higher knowledge which helps man to rise above the worldly agonies; knowing which everything else of the world is known. It is also believed that a person bereft of spiritual knowledge can never bring any worldly activity to success. Thus, there is great importance of spiritualism in Indian life.

**Haridwar** -- Haridwar, literally **Gateway to God**, is one of the Hindu holy places in India and a center of Hindu religion and mysticism for centuries. Located on the banks of River Ganges (*Ganga*), at the point where the Ganges descends from the hills to the North Indian plains, Haridwar attracts a large number of Hindu pilgrims from all over the world.

**Rishikesh** - Rishikesh is a city in India's northern state of Uttarakhand, in the Himalayan foothills beside the Ganges River. The river is considered holy, and the city is renowned as a center for studying yoga and meditation. Temples and ashrams (centers for spiritual studies) line the eastern bank around Swarg Ashram, a traffic-free, alcohol-free and vegetarian enclave upstream from Rishikesh town.

**DETAILED ITINERARY:**

**Day 01: ARRIVE DELHI**



Meet upon arrival at Indira Gandhi International Airport and transfer to hotel.

**Day 02: Delhi - Haridwar (210 kms/6hrs)**

Morning start from Delhi to Haridwar, upon arrival check into the hotel. Visit Har-ki-Pauri for Ganga Aarti in evening. The 'Aarti' worship of the Ganga after sunset and the floating 'dia' (lamp) is a moving ritual. Overnight stay at hotels.

**Haridwar** has very rich very old religious and cultural heritage. Sited in the foothills of the Himalayas, Haridwar is a tourist hot-spot. Haridwar

You will see a great statue of Shiva at the fork of the river. If you are there for a short visit, it is beyond doubt worth to visit the temple on top of the mountain, with a breath taking view.

**Day 03: Haridwar – Rishikesh (20 kms/38 Min)**



Morning visit **Har Ki Pauri**: Har-Ki-Pauri is the sacred Ghat was constructed by King Vikramaditya in memory of his brother Bhartrihari. It is believed that Bhartihari eventually came to Haridwar to meditate by the banks of the holy Ganga. When he died, his brother constructed the Ghat in his name which later came to be known as Har-Ki-Pauri. This sacred bathing Ghat is also known as Brahmakund where thousands of devotees perform rituals. After Haridwar Local Sight Seeing drive to Rishikesh. **Rishikesh**, the 'place of sages' is a celebrated spiritual town on the bank of Ganga and is surrounded by Shivalik range of the Himalayas on three

sides. It is said That when Raibhya Rishi did hard penances, God appeared by the name of "Hrishikesh" and this area hence firth came to be known as Rishikesh.

### Day 04: Rishikesh

In the morning visit - Laxman Jhulla, Ram Jhulla, Triveni Ghat, Bharat Mandir, Shivananda Ashram. Evening time visit the Ghat's to encounter evening Ghat life as well as Parmarth Ashram for special Aarti "The Prayer dedicated to Goddess Ganges" the town of ashrams and temples, Ghats and pilgrims, mountains and the holy Ganges. When global orange sun suspended, waits low amid the red/yellow streaked horizon, then all these combine to give this town a very special evening. The temple bells roar, priests enchant mantras. Immersed in sublimation stand the pilgrims. Cupped leaves, with saffron marigold petals and a small candle flame, flickering ride the current of water of wisdom. Suddenly the sky darkens, spreading a blanket of stillness. Everything stops, except the sound of current, which has just sunk the tiny flames of cupped leaves, few minutes back.



After experiencing above we trace our steps back to the hotel. One can have dinner at famous Chotiwalla restaurant.

### Day 05: Rishikesh - Delhi (230kms/6-7hr)



Early morning drive back to Delhi. Arrive Delhi. Later proceed for city of New Delhi, visit President House, India Gate and Humayun's Tomb and Dilli Haat. In the evening transfer to the airport to board the flight for onward destination.
